- Treat all players in my sport as I like to be treated. I will not bully or take unfair advantage of another competitor.
- Cooperate with my coach, team-mates, and opponents.
- Care for and respect the facilities and equipment made available to during training and competition.
- Train and play to the best of my ability.
- Arrive promptly and ready to go, for practices and games. I will always notify the coach immediately if I cannot attend a practice or game.
