

Catching the Bus - Port Chalmers 2019

Please note that as of March 23 the bus hub has opened, which means the routes have changed a little as detailed below.

In order to get a free transfer between zones students will need to be using a GoCard and must catch the second bus within 30 minutes of the first. GoCards can be purchased on the bus for \$5 and must be topped up with a \$10 minimum so if you don't already own one you can buy one on Wednesday morning on the bus but you'll need \$15 cash.

From then onwards, the cards can be topped up on the bus (\$10 minimum in cash) or at the ORC, DCC or University Bookshop.

Getting to School

Students should now stay on the Port Chalmers Bus which will stop at Bus Hub (G) and continue to the Bus Hub (D) where they will be able to transfer to a Normanby bus for free (as long as they use a GoCard).



The 7.50am bus from Port will arrive at Bus Hub G at 8.21 and the Normanby bus will leave Hub D at 8.29am which will have kids at school by 8.45am.

Alternatively, students can get off at The Clubs and Society Building on Albany Street as pictured below. They should then walk up Albany Street to George Street and wait outside Knox Church as per usual.





The St Clair - Normanby Bus comes every 15 minutes and this trip will be free by tapping your GoCard. Note - you can go as far as Pet Planet at the Gardens, then use the road crossings to walk to DNI.



Getting home from school

Students should get on the bus outside DNI at 3.07pm



They should get off at 472 George Street (just past The Lone Star) at 3.17pm. This will cost 2 zones, but they will then get a free zone when they board the next bus, assuming they have their GoCard.

They then need to walk back towards DNI and cross the road at the Rob Roy Dairy, turning right down Albany Street towards the Museum. The bus stop is on Albany Street, outside the Museum grounds.



The bus leaves here at 3.34pm and again at 4.04pm
